- ❖ Final Reception and Awards

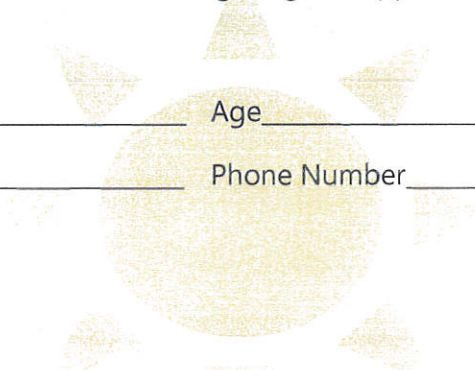
